



Google Classroom Administrator Guide

DISTRICT IT

Optional, read-only roster import for ClassPlaybook teachers

Purpose

A teacher may choose to copy student display names from one Google Classroom course into a ClassPlaybook roster. This integration is not required for normal ClassPlaybook use.

Administrator approval steps

- 1 Confirm **Google Classroom is enabled** for the teacher's staff organizational unit.
- 2 In Google Admin, open **Security > Access and data control > API controls > Manage third-party app access**.
- 3 Search for and approve ClassPlaybook using the public OAuth client ID shown below.
- 4 Allow both read-only Classroom permissions. Ask the teacher to retry and select both permission checkboxes on Google's consent screen.

Required read-only permissions

Courses

Rosters

ClassPlaybook can

- List classes taught by the authorized teacher.
- Read display names from the class the teacher selects.
- Use the temporary Google access token during that import.

ClassPlaybook cannot

- Change assignments, grades, courses, or rosters.
- Import a class the teacher did not select.
- Store the Google access token in classroom data or the ClassPlaybook database.

Verification

Before testing in ClassPlaybook, sign into classroom.google.com with the same school account. If Google reports that Classroom is unavailable, enable the Classroom service for that user or organizational unit first. Google notes that service-status changes can take up to 24 hours.
